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



Culley Road basks in the Mediterranean climate of McLaren Vale. This is a big and intense red wine – think cherries and blackcurrants with a dusting of pepper-powered mocha. They'll evolve beautifully in the cellar for the next 10 years.

Grown in South Australia's cool maritime Limestone Coast, warm windy days limit berry size for super flavour concentration, and sea breezes reduce the temperature to retain the natural grape acids during the ripening. Aromas of pear, lychee and quince. Flavours of ripe quince and ripe fruits on the palate.

Bec Hardy Wines is a family-owned wine business based in McLaren Vale, South Australia. Bec is a sixth generation member of, and the first female vigneron from, one of Australia's oldest wine families, the Hardys.

The Hardy name has been synonymous with South Australian wine since the 1850s and Bec Hardy continues that tradition, building on the experience and reputation of her predecessors.

Bec's family has been tending vineyards in the premium maritime region of McLaren Vale since her great-great-great grandfather, Thomas Hardy, arrived from the UK in 1850. Thomas is widely regarded as the father of the South Australian wine industry.

Today, Bec Hardy Wines, a certified member of Sustainable Winegrowing Australia, produces awardwinning wines from several premium South Australian wine regions, including McLaren Vale, Adelaide Hills and Langhorne Creek.



By 1996, our vineyards and newly constructed winery was complete. First vintage at Cape Jaffa Wines was in 1996. We have always approached farming, production and life with a holistic frame of mind. In 2005, we achieved biodynamic certification and became pioneers for biodynamic winemaking in South Australia.

Today, Cape Jaffa Wines is a three-generation family business. Winemaking and farming is in our blood, we are passionate about existing with minimal trace and effect on the land we call home. We operate our entire facility off-grid, relying on solar and wind for the majority of our power source. Although very serious about our purpose and goals, we sure do love a good time. 

Metala Wines





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Metala Wines founder, William Formby, arrived in South Australia from the United Kingdom in 1839. In 1882 he purchased the now historic Metala in Langhorne Creek and in 1891 planted the first Shiraz and, what are now the oldest family-owned Cabernet Sauvignon vines in the world, on the estate. After winning the inaugural Jimmy Watson Trophy in 1962, Metala grew in popularity and from the late 1970s was under the ownership of various holdings. After a 20-year long battle, in 2022 fifth generation, Guy Adams, returned Metala to Langhorne Creek and the family legacy.



Seppeltsfield is one of Australia's most historic wineries, established in the Barossa in 1851. Located on the 'western ridge' of the Barossa, Seppeltsfield combines over 420 acres of ancient vineyard, gardens and heritagelisted architecture.

Seppeltsfield winery and vineyards attained full sustainability certification in 2023 in line with our Sustainability Action Plan. We use the Freshcare Australian Wine Industry Standard of Sustainable Practice – Winery Standard and the Sustainable Winegrowing Australia program, to demonstrate our commitment to sustainability.

Seppeltsfield has long been internationally renowned for its treasure trove of fortified wines, highlighted by the Centennial Collection – the world's only unbroken lineage of single vintage Tawny dating back to 1878. But the star is starting to shine on the 172-year-old estate's new chapter – the luxury collection of still wines, only possible since gaining full ownership of its trademark in 2017.

Located on the cusp of Marananga and Greenock, the establishment of Utopos Vineyards began in 1974 on a bed of lean and depleted stoney soils that significantly limits yield. This outstanding geology allows us to grow cracking concentrated yet balanced grapes on these shallow, ancient soils – fruit that was traditionally sent to the corporate end of town, where the small crop of coveted fruit often found its way into their icon wines.

A hallmark of the Utopos Vineyard on Roennfeldt Road is the pitch perfect acid/tannin balance we can achieve in fully ripened fruit. This provides for delicious, highly approachable wines in their youth, while enabling them to develop over a 10–15 year period, and maybe more.
